A candidate must have cleared all papers in the University Examinations; any backlog of paper shall render him/her disqualified.

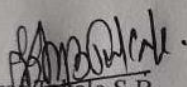
A candidate must have attained a good attendance record; he must have satisfied the university norms (75%) in the preceding semester (s).

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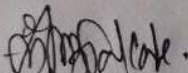
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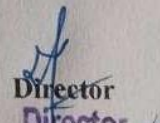
